This data management software gives social service agencies a simpler way to manage people, track participation, & document progress across programs, services & sites. By uniting real data requirements with a deep understanding of day-to-day operations, TIDEL is designed to be used easily, so that will be used consistently.***

### **Configuration & Access**

- ◆ Meets FERPA & HIPPA requirements
- ◆ Custom roles & permissions at agency & program level
- ◆ Multiple credentialing & authorizing methods
- ◆ Unique user IDs & logins
- ◆ Accessible via mobile web browsers
- ◆ Import historic data - *data from TPS will be updated at the end of each week*



### **Manage Participants, Staff & Volunteers**

- ◆ Record detailed contact & demographic data
- ◆ Capture participant information longitudinally
- ◆ Track participation status
- ◆ Share participants across a common directory
- ◆ Associate staff with program activities based on roles



## Manage Program Services

- ◆ Track individual participant attendance
- ◆ Create service activities & schedules
- ◆ Assign staff & partners at service level
- ◆ Track attendance by hours, sessions, & days
- ◆ Record non-individual attendance for events
- ◆ Option to use inexpensive USB barcode scanners



## Track Outcomes & Manage Reports

- ◆ Use built-in standard reports for common report metrics
- ◆ Summarize data by participant, activity, & programs
- ◆ Administer surveys to participants, families, & staff
